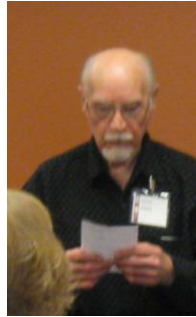
Jerry Schmidt shared a couple gnarled trees he painted



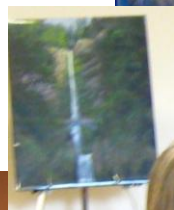
Marshall Baretta brought his bird painting and prints of the 4 local birds he did for a friend

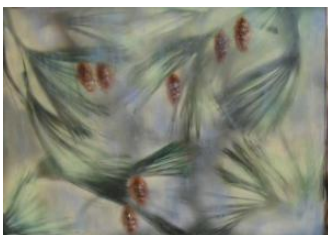
