Previously scheduled workshop by President Shirlee Lind will be rescheduled later this spring. No workshop will be held in January.

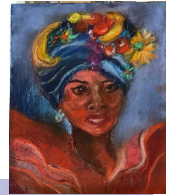
NCAG member Bonnie Moore will present her watercolor workshop in February 2018.

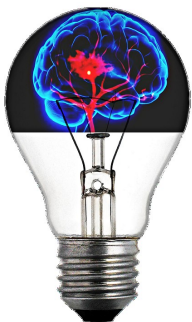

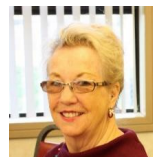
