

From Pam Davis: Gallery wrap canvas needs no frame but be sure to paint the edges of the board. No glass on oil paintings. Dust paper on the

back needs slits to allow the painting to breath. This paper cover is essential if there are paint smudges showing on the back of the canvas as it can be seen from the other side of our frames.

Be sure to put your business card & a designed card with the painting information, artist & the price on the back of the frame
