This a juried art show open to residents of Oregon and Washington State. A non-refundable \$20 jury fee application is due no later than **April 15, 2019**.

Call to Artists

If selected, the booth fee is \$125 for both days. This includes your booth space (10' x 10') and marketing for the Oregon City Festival of the Arts. Two artists may share a booth and art must be compatible. Both must be juried in and send in separate applications and jury fees. You will share the booth fee of \$125.

Jury results will be sent out by **May 1, 2019**. Booth payment is due no later than June 30, 2019.
